Dept. namely 06 seats in Organon, 05 seats in Materia Medica and 03 seats each in the Dept. of Repertory & Practice of Medicine for the academic session 2020-21-reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the Part-1 of the proforma of inspection of college submitted by the **Dr. B.D. Jatti Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital** and furnished the recommended for allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of 100 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course and 17 PG seats in M.D. (Hom) Course with 06 seats in the Dept. of Organon, 05 seats in Materia Medica, and 03 seats each in the Dept. of Practice of Medicine & Repertory.

2. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, **permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Dr. B.D. Jatti Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital D.C. Compound, Dharwad, Karnataka-580001 for continuing admissions in 1- BHMS course during the academic year 2020-21 with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course and 17 PG seats in M.D. (Hom) Course with 06 seats in the Dept. of Organon, 05 seats in Materia Medica, and 03 seats each in the Dept. of Practice of Medicine & Repertory, subject to availability of full time Yoga expert & Physiotherapist and updated website before 31st December, 2020.**

3. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and 15 % of Post Graduate of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course and MD(Hom.) course

respectively shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government vide letter F. No. L. 11011/02/2020-E- (1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

5. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

6. Further, the College shall submit comply with the procedure to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st December, 2020 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.

7. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31st December, 2020 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2021-22 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
